1. All servers are expected to be at the church 15 minutes before Mass begins.
2. All servers are to sign in when they serve.
3. All servers are expected to fulfill their assigned times to serve.
4. All servers are expected to find their own replacement if they cannot make it for whatever reason.
5. All servers are expected to wear "Sunday clothes" at the weekend Masses.
6. All servers are expected to hang up their vestments after Mass.
7. All servers are expected to pay attention to the Priest and participate fully during Mass.
8. All servers are expected to know and say the appropriate responses throughout the Mass.
9. **All servers are expected to make the commitment to be regularly schedule during each schedule period.**
10. **All servers are expected to occasionally serve at the 11:00 am Sunday Mass.**
