A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR

Happy Thanksgiving! I hope each of you will have a time to be with family and friends and time to spend a moment thanking God for all the gifts we receive be it family and friends, the food that nourishes us, the beauty that surrounds us and knowledge that we are God's beloved daughters and sons!



It is not a holy day, but if you can, I invite you to come to the morning Mass on Thanksgiving Day at 9:00 AM. Bring some of the bread and wine that will be served later at the Thanksgiving feast you attend or are preparing. This is a wonderful way to start the celebration and what it means as a country and as individuals and families.

This is a great time to acknowledge all who make our parish what it is and hopes to be. Citing our mission statement: We are a welcoming, active Catholic community united by our faith, open to transformation, growing spiritually and reaching out to love and server others as Jesus taught us.

I am sincerely grateful for all who help us live and practice our mission statement! I am grateful for every donor who supports the work of the parish with your weekly contribution and who always gives more when a special need is announced. I am grateful and awed by each and every volunteer who makes sure the candles are lit, the readings are proclaimed loud and clear, the food bags are carried out to the car waiting to bring it to the pantry. I give thanks for those who pray the rosary every morning for the parish and other needs, for parents who make sure their children are learning about Jesus and the Church in our school and religious education programs and especially their homes, for our young people who are contemplating a lifelong commitment to Jesus and the Church by participating in the Confirmation program and for every child that sings out at our Masses and reminds us what Jesus meant when he said, 'unless you become like a little child. I am grateful for a committed and diligent staff that often go above and beyond job descriptions and expected hours to get the job done. I am grateful for the witness of faith that I have experienced in so many of you! There are many other things and individuals I thank God for, and I tried to pray for all of you during my retreat two weeks ago. I will leave this paragraph open because there is so much more to be grateful for this Thanksgiving.

Sometimes someone asks how long I have practiced being a priest This week, I celebrate the forty second anniversary of my ordination as a priest. I give thanks to God for the gift of this call and that I have had the joy to serve that call here at St. Theresa's for the past twelve years. My prayer for all of us is a prayer I paraphrase that the bishop prayed over me at my ordination: "May God who have begun the good work in us, bring it to completion." Since I am still practicing, once again, if I have hurt anyone or not served as you needed, please forgive me. I hope the few more years that God gives me will only improve my practice.

I have been writing about Catholic Social Justice for the past few weeks to remind us how to build a just society and live lives of holiness at a time when wars ravage our planet. We can and do make a difference in our world! The 'two feet of love in action' calls us to respond to make that difference. The USCCB site sums up our actions (adapted for St. T) in the following terms:

St. Theresa of Calcutta wrote" It is not how much we do, but how much love we have..." So, the actions we might engage in:

- We **pray** individually and in community for the grace and guidance of the Holy Spirit and for those we serve.
- We educate by writing articles in our parish bulletin and flock notes, participating in the presentations sponsored by the St. Theresa Social Justice Committee, the California Catholic Conference and other Church and secular agencies.
- We advocate through opportunities provided by the California Catholic Conference. We use our voices to discuss social justice issues with our neighbors, family, fellow parishioners, and others who cross our path.
- We act by providing assistance to individuals and families in various ways throughout the year. (support for St. Vincent DePaul conference, sock, and backpack collections, giving tree at Christmas time, support for Corazon and sponsored immigrant families, etc.)

Have a great Thanksgiving if you are not here for Mass. Travel well and safely if you are on the move. As mentioned above: May the good things God has begun in us receive growth and perfection!
