
# ST. THERESA SCHOOL

# A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR

Continued Easter greetings and I hope everyone celebrated well this core mystery of our faith. In our world that seems to continue with tragedy after tragedy, we live in hope that God's will



one day will wipe every tear from our eyes and will usher us with friends and family to God's holy mountain!

Until we reach that beatific vision, I am finally happy to report that thanks to your ongoing generosity the church building finally has a new roof. It is guaranteed for ten years, but we expect it to last longer. We have waited more than ten years, in part because I and the Finance Council were concerned about the debt that may have been incurred due to the repairs needed for the Event Center/Gym. Paul Bongiovanni, who has been the Diocesan CFO for more than ten years and just retired from this job on March 31, found ways to keep that new debt down and so we can begin to address normal and side-lined needs of an aging parish plant.

Please say a prayer of blessing for Paul that his retirement will be wonderful. Please say a prayer for the many who have contributed over the years to build and maintain and repair our parish facilities! I will continue to remember all of you in my Masses with gratitude and esteem.

This weekend, we kick off the annual Bishop's Appeal. You will see an eight-minute video that presents what exactly this appeal will support this year. St. Theresa has been given the same goal that we had the past four years. Your generosity has helped us reach our goal gradually through the years past. Once again, I encourage you to

continue that generosity. It makes a difference to many.

Last weekend, I joined a group of thirty-six present and former parishioners who traveled south to build a house in a single day for a family that has waited many years for a solid roof over their heads. When the diocese withdrew its support and permission for this venture, many of you did not let that stop this project that has changed lives for many on both sides of the southern border. Many of you have continued to support these efforts with your donations.

I want to shout out gratitude to the coordinators: George Donovan, Paulette Tuckner and Jenny Bruni and to all who gave support and participated. I am overjoyed that as the bus was returning some were already talking about the next opportunity to do this great work of charity.

I am so proud of the young people especially our Confirmation candidates who helped make this a success. I am so proud of all who have chosen to get through the roadblocks to bring comfort to a family in need and encouragement to all of us on how to live out Jesus' command to us to love our neighbor. I joined the build this year because it is a great way for me to celebrate reaching 70 and thank God for the abundant blessings God has showered on me through these years.

The above is one of many ways and things that are special about St. Theresa Parish in Oakland. As we continue to plan how we will celebrate 100 years as a parish, I know this will have a spotlight and be a beacon to others about who we are and what we profess. This community has always cared of those in need. May the good things God has begun in us be brought one day to completion!
