A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR

Congratulations to our eighth-grade class who were promoted to high school last Friday afternoon. They join an illustrious group of St. Theresa students who have gone off to different high schools, colleges



and universities and professional schools. Some have taken other paths, but many, many have done well with the foundation of St. Theresa School since 1958.

My hope is that as the parish celebrates one hundred years, next year a vital component will be our alumni and knowing about the many paths our students have taken over the years. I am saying this, hoping that there are some out there now who will be willing to tell stories, find photos, provide alumni addresses and make comments about how St. Theresa School was an important foundation for the rest of their lives.
