

A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR

I hope by the time you read this; it is cooler for all of us! We are not used to the extreme heat we have experienced over the past few days. We are used to a hot day here and there and then the wonderful fog cools us off again. I know this is just another sign that global warming is real and



anyone who writes that off is delusional and not paying attention to truth, facts and what we are experiencing.

Please keep tabs on one another. Many people have difficulties because they do not stay hydrated or think we do things outside as business as usual and bigger problems happen because of it. Part of being a member of a parish and following Christ is that we care and sometime take care of our neighbor. If there is anyone in need, please let me or a staff member know so we can try to assist as we are able.

Thanks to all of you who have supported our St. Vincent DePaul Conference with your donation on the fifth Sunday months and with your food items that are collected in the vestibule of the church. As you arrive today you will find a large box in the vestibule for the StVdP 'Socktober' collection. A flyer in another part of this bulletin explains that new socks for children and adults are collected and will be distributed via the various sites of the county society. I have heard from more than one homeless person or family in need, sincere appreciation for the simple gift of a clean, warm pair of new socks. I look forward to seeing this box brim over soon with the socks we bring.

From time to time, individuals, usually a woman and a young child appear outside the church as Mass gets out with a sign and they beg for your assistance. I am happy to report that after I tried to ask the most recent person who did this a week ago to go off the parish property, that I was able to connect them with our local St. Vincent Conference who has been able to assist them. Our parishioners learned that this family is here for medical reasons from Texas and another parish in Alameda had already assisted them. Most of the food that you have brought recently was given to them as well as other assistance. This is directly due to your ongoing generosity.

It is never, I will say it again, never just hand out cash. But we have this conference in place to assist those who come to us and as I thank you for your past help, please continue to enable our St. Vincent Conference to do this work in all our names to the praise of our God!

You remember from previous Octobers, that we emphasize respecting all life each year. This respect starts with reverence, care, and respect for the newest infant in utero to several parishioners who have just turned 94, 99 and 100.

St. Theresa has a reputation through our hundred years of amazing generosity, in just the buildings those before us have built to house our worship and educate the children of the parish to the establishment of FACE, the outreach to all who lost homes in the October fire a few years ago, and the families who now live in a house because many of you traveled to a concrete pad via Corazon and left a built house at the end of a long day.

As the '100th Jubilee' committee has met, I have just suggested that we highlight some of the ordinary and extraordinary works of charity that have been generated from this parish. This is certainly a wonderful facet of 'respecting life' that we should remember, celebrate, and help motivate future actions on our part as a parish. Therefore, I am asking that if you remember an outreach, campaign, or program the parish supported to let me or someone on the Jubilee committee know about it. I remember, Msgr. Moran telling and sending me some literature about supporting a religious sister somewhere south of the border. FACE has helped school children in our parochial school system for many years and recently helped one or two of our own children. I have picture books of dinners in the parish hall that benefited some parish outreach at the time.

I suggest we remember them during our Jubilee year and let them encourage us as we go forward with the next hundred years to look for other situations where we can help. I welcome you own suggestions for this and want that facet of giving beyond the parish part of the approaching Jubilee.
