A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR

As we begin the full holiday season with Thanksgiving this week, it is an opportunity to say thank you to all the benefactors who sustained the parish and its mission throughout the whole year. This year we

have been able finally to put a new roof and paint the church building as major projects that could never have happened without the ongoing weekly and on occasion special support you have generously contributed.

Last week there was a special Mass for all parishioners who have died, and all the 'people of the parish' are prayed for at a weekly Mass usually on the weekend. As I preside at this Mass, I always ask God to hear and answer your prayers and bless a hundred-fold the gift you have shared to make things happen and the many repairs you do not see but count on so we can continue the work and mission of our parish. I sincerely pray that God will abundantly bless you again and again.

I am sure you have received appeals from some of the other charities you have contributed to over the years reminding you that December 3 is 'Giving Tuesday'. I have heard from the schools I've attended, Catholic Charities and other programs I have personally supported through the years. approach our Jubilee Year of 100 years since the founding of our parish.

May those who have gone before us pray for us and may God bless each of you as you now ensure the legacy they established when the parish was founded and sustained since 1925!

With our Jubilee Committee up and running with plans for many moments of celebrations to come throughout next year, as we think about who we can invite to 'Come home to the parish for Christmas', I ask all to think about fellow parishioners who have moved away because of the fire, or a job transfer, or other reason and if you know how to contact them, please let us know.
