A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR

Welcome back to the end of summer and beginning of a new school year! I hope and pray you all had some kind of restful vacation or time to recharge and are ready to engage in the schoolwork and other work that we do each fall.



I was able to make twelve wonderful snorkel adventures in the very warm and clear waters of Bonaire again. I slept, deleted 5K emails from my trove, enjoyed the company of friends and read four books that weren't connected to work.

Our annual 'Back to School' Mass brings students, teachers, parents and friends together and I hope all will enjoy the gathering with a Taco truck this year as we do what is so important for any parish: fellowship, making connections and stepping up to help to continue the good things we have celebrated here at St. Theresa Parish for the past hundred years.

St. Theresa of the Child Jesus was canonized on May 16, 1925. Our parish was established on October 15, 1925 which makes us one of the first parishes named in her honor and seeking her prayers for us. Her 'little way', writings, example, and devotion has guided the lives of millions of people during the last hundred years even though she never left the small Carmelite convent she entered at a very young age and where she died at the very young age of 24.

To celebrate, honor her and ask again for her patronage, prayers and love we have remembered the Baptisms, Communions and Confirmations of thousands who have celebrated these sacraments at our parish. We will soon remember weddings and our parishioners who have passed as a small tribute.

Saturday, the Taco truck was another way to get us to be together and enjoy our common purpose to live the Christian life and pursue a path for all to get to Heaven. I encourage you to get on your schedules our feast day celebration when we celebrate Mass together outside and enjoy games and food for all. The annual Auction is on the night of October 25th and school and parishioners are all invited to a great night of fun, food and bargains to be had. January a more formal dinner/dance will cap off the year of celebrations.

We do these things and more, not to raise funds but to help us remember that we are the beloved of God. God makes us part of one family when we join ourselves to Christ. As part of that family we help each other and journey with each other in the joys and sorrows of this life and hopefully lead each other to where our patron, St. Theresa is forever with God, all the angels and saints and those even from our parish and families who we pray are now in heaven.

Every family has family pictures that are treasured and displayed. As soon as school starts, each student will get the new year's picture taken. Over the hundred years, the parish has produced pictorial directory's which helps us know each other better as we seek to be the family Christ is calling us to be. Happily we are putting together the latest edition, and everyone is asked to participate and get their individual or family picture taken. When I arrived fourteen years ago, you all knew my name and even though I asked that you keep telling me your name for my first six months, few of you complied with my request. I can't tell you how many times through the fourteen years when someone has called and I don't recognize the name I immediately go to this picture book and then recognize the face with the name. I also do this when a family is asking for the parish tuition rate because other things are disputing that in our system.

Recently, a dear parishioner asked me what happened to the lady who sits near the back on the left side. I asked who they were talking about, and they said, well you should know without giving me a name. I said, well you have been in the parish for over fifty years so you should know their name even better! The parish directory is a great tool for all of us to know each other better which is what the Lord intended when he says we are family. Please make this the fullest directory yet and if you are expecting a perk from at the school maintaining parishioner status, this is a small effort to assure that will go through.
