



## A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR

Happy Mother's Day! Where would any of us be without our Moms? This will be a vastly different day for the Moms unlike any other. I am looking forward to hearing on the news some of the creative ways people will honor their moms today without the traditional brunch or other gatherings. I think if anyone still has their mom, they deserve a rain check for that traditional way when we can come together with each other again. I know many moms who usually go to work are trying to work at home and at the same time keep their children on track with the attempts of online learning.

Thanks to many of you who have sent in photos of your Mom. There has been a great response and since we cannot hand out prayer cards, we bless and pray for each Grandmother, Godmother, Great Grandmother, mother, expectant mothers and for anyone who has been like a mother to us.

I remember when I was a boy, when I got sick, or hurt, frightened or anxious, confused, or shocked, I knew my Mom would be there to comfort me. In vastly different ways this year I know our moms are doing the same for their families. We honor them, pray for them, and ask God to bless them!

I am getting cabin fever and have probably been out to the store more than others (with all precautions in place). As a state we are doing it well and beating the virus. Let us hang on for a time when this will be a bad memory and the subject that someone will make a movie about by next year at this time.

I am grateful for many who have sent words of encouragement to me or a member of the parish staff and school staff for what we have tried to do. The online streaming of Sunday Mass gets immediate positive comments. At our zoom staff meeting the subject came up about what more can we do? Would you join and participate in a zoom prayer group (several are already doing this since our confinement)? Would you want a bible study? Would a support group for those who have been laid off be established? How about a support group for parents trying to balance working at home and having the children very close? Do you have any

suggestions? Please let me or a member of the parish staff hear from you?



During the month of May, as Catholics we traditionally focus on Holy Mary. Pope Francis has written two prayers to be said after the rosary at this time (they can be found on the parish website.) A week ago, Friday led by Archbishop Gomez of Los Angeles and our own bishop, we as a church re-dedicated ourselves to implore Holy Mary's protection. Her is a simple summary about our devotion to the Mother of God written by a permanent deacon:

*By Deacon Keith Fournier*

"The Catechism of the Catholic Church instructs the faithful on just how Mary prayed. Mary still prays. She has a special role in the plan of salvation and is a model for all Christians: "Mary's prayer is revealed to us at the dawning of the fullness of time. Before the incarnation of the Son of God, and before the outpouring of the Holy Spirit, her prayer cooperates in a unique way with the Father's plan of loving kindness: At the Annunciation, for Christ's conception; at Pentecost, for the formation of the Church, his Body."

In the faith of his humble handmaid, the Gift of God found the acceptance he had awaited from the beginning of time. She whom the Almighty made "full of grace" responds by offering her whole being: "Behold I am the handmaid of the Lord; let it be [done] to me according to your word." "Fiat": this is Christian prayer: to be wholly God's because he is wholly ours.

The Gospel reveals to us how Mary prays and intercedes in faith. At Cana, the mother of Jesus asks her son for the needs of a wedding feast; this is the sign of another feast - that of the wedding of the Lamb where he gives his body and blood at the request of the Church, his Bride. It is at the hour of the New Covenant, at the foot of the cross, that Mary is heard as the

Woman, the new Eve, the true "Mother of all the living."

That is why the Canticle of Mary, the Magnificat (Latin) or is the song both of the Mother of God and of the Church; the song of the Daughter of Zion and of the new People of God; the song of thanksgiving for the fullness of graces poured out in the economy of salvation and the song of the "poor" whose hope is met by the fulfillment of the promises made to our ancestors, "to Abraham and to his posterity forever" (CCC #2617-2619).

Mary, the Mother of the Lord, is also our Mother as members of His family, His Body, the Church. She is a powerful intercessor in that family. Just as her intercession at the Wedding of Cana moved the heart of her Son, so her intercession on our behalf continues to move His Sacred Heart. Our Marian devotion and prayer are a treasure which leads us, as does all genuine Marian devotion, closer to her Son and into the communion of love in which she now participates in glory. We participate in that communion even now and her prayers assist us in our journey to its fullness."

As we honor Holy Mary and again ask for her intercession when at the same time, we honor our moms, may our prayers soon be answered for an end of the pandemic and a return of freedom to roam around.



## April Showers Bring May Flowers
