## CONFIRMATION MINISTRY

Hello St. Theresa community. I'm writing on this special weekend for all of us involved with Confirmation ministry. This Saturday evening, 16 of our high school sophomores were to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. Sadly, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the diocese has cancelled all Confirmation Liturgies for the month of May.

These 16 confirmandi have prepared diligently for the past two years, asking questions, supporting each other, growing in faith, sharing experiences, and building relationships with many who have now taken a spot in the shaping of their spiritual life.

I would be greatly remiss if I, first of all, did not mention and give high praise to our many confirmation leaders who have given tirelessly and have journeyed with our confirmandi: Sabrina Chaumette, Jim Frei, and Bob Hernandez – Year II leaders, Mike Cain, Jim Cunniffe, and Emily Sullivan – Year I leaders, and supplementary leaders and mentors in faith: Laura Goslee, John Leighton, Savannah Reed, and Witt Turner. Our leaders are a key component to the success of our confirmation program. They are spiritual mentors sharing stories of their challenges, their discoveries, their faith, their hope, and their love. We have been blessed with supplementary leaders who have been examples of young men and women of faith, walking and supporting those who are preparing to be confirmed – giving of their time so generously to join us for sessions, retreats, and online-sessions, too.

We often wonder what roles our young, newly confirmed parishioners are engaged? Well, these young women and men minister to our community as Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion at our annual outdoor Fall "Festival" Mass, Rise & Shine Masses, and additional weekend liturgies. They also join us at our sessions as guest and panel speakers, and retreat leaders. Many thanks to these young women and men who have shown us how we live out our faith in our community: Tadhg McInerney, Nico Estilo, Tristan Bruni, Kaitlyn Iglesias, Paloma Canales, Paige Anderson, Savannah Reed, John Leighton, Luke Olmos, and Witt Turner.

We cannot forget our parents, our first teachers in our faith who brought us to baptism. At our baptisms, our parents promised God that they accept the responsibility of supporting and nurturing our faith. Parents, thank you for encouraging, though not always easy, your teen-children to attend Mass and our sessions. Thank you for reminding them, "remember, Mrs. Bruni said you need to dress appropriately for Mass," only to be given the response, "she also said that God loves us as we are, no matter what." Thank you for nourishing these young growing bodies with their favorite breakfast treats so that on Sundays they can be nourished spiritually and then physically. Thank you for modeling your Christian faith by coming to Mass with them and showing them that celebrating the eucharist is not just something they should do, but something we all should do. Although this probably did not make you very popular to them, thank you for supporting me when I would ask them to fill in as an altar server when we didn't have any for Mass. As a former confirmation student told me many years ago, "we fill the need," and our confirmandi are learning this well. Thank you to the parents who have given so generously to our service projects, from teaching our young ladies how to set a beautiful table for Advent By Candlelight, to financially supporting and guiding us in the kitchen at GRIP to provide a meal for families in need, to pumping out a pancake breakfast for our parish community to raise funds for a housebuilding project for two families in dire need, to giving generously to deliver a meal to homeless and struggling seniors at St. Mary's Center during the beginning of the COVID-19 pandemic.

### ***Now back to our very special 16 confirmandi...***

I can confidently say that our confirmandi have prepared very well. I commend them for having committed these past two years to learning and practicing discipleship. They've attended Mass and their twice monthly sessions, participated in a variety of service projects, attended yearly retreats, and most importantly have been open to letting the Spirit move and be at work in each of them in their individual ways. I've seen their faith strengthen and grow when they sincerely pray for those in need and give thanks to our Lord

Jesus for the abundance of blessings they've received. I've seen them grow a desire of discipleship when they eagerly want to be part of our community by assisting Miss Margaret with handing out bulletins after Mass, when they line up to take a collection basket or bring up the offertory gifts. I see their faith mature each time they step up to lead prayer. The moments I see a young lady or young man speak up for what is just and direct her/his peers reminds me that these young people have the Holy Spirit already working inside each one of them... they are just waiting for that wonderful moment to be SEALED with the Holy Spirit so that they can go and move about in the world bringing the love of Christ to others.

So during this time of waiting as I'm sure many confirmandi and parents are becoming anxious and wondering when this confirmation will happen, I share with you some thoughts from Cardinal Dolan. He reminds us, "this is when our faith needs to kick in... maybe this time of waiting will strengthen our faith so that we can better confirm our faith." Cardinal Dolan also encourages us to repeatedly say and pray to ourselves "Come Holy Spirit." As one of the young ladies in confirmation told us all during our online session in April, we are living during a time of history that people will talk about. To you, young confirmandi, you will have a story to tell when you reminisce on your extra time of waiting. And as it may be challenging to see light through this darkness at times, and there will be more times of darkness and challenge, I encourage and remind each of us to keep looking to those you've journeyed with to see the face of Christ and feel the love of Christ. So maybe this time of waiting will make it even more exciting and meaningful. Like your parents and sponsors, Fr. Bob, and your confirmation leaders, I look forward to witnessing each of our confirmandi affirm their baptism, receive the Gifts of the Holy Spirit, and be sealed with the Holy Spirit. I look forward to each of you going out and setting the world on fire in your unique ways. So, with love and faith, I ask you to pray with me "Come Holy Spirit."

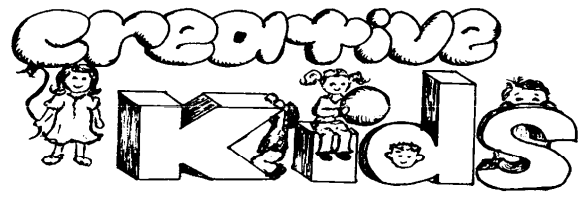

## Coffee Filter Butterfly

You will need:

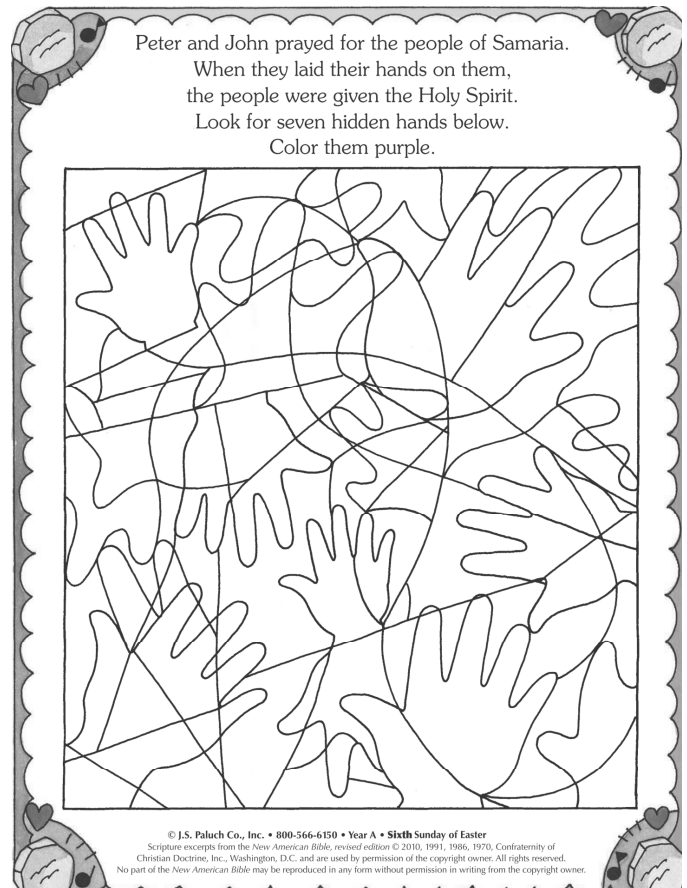
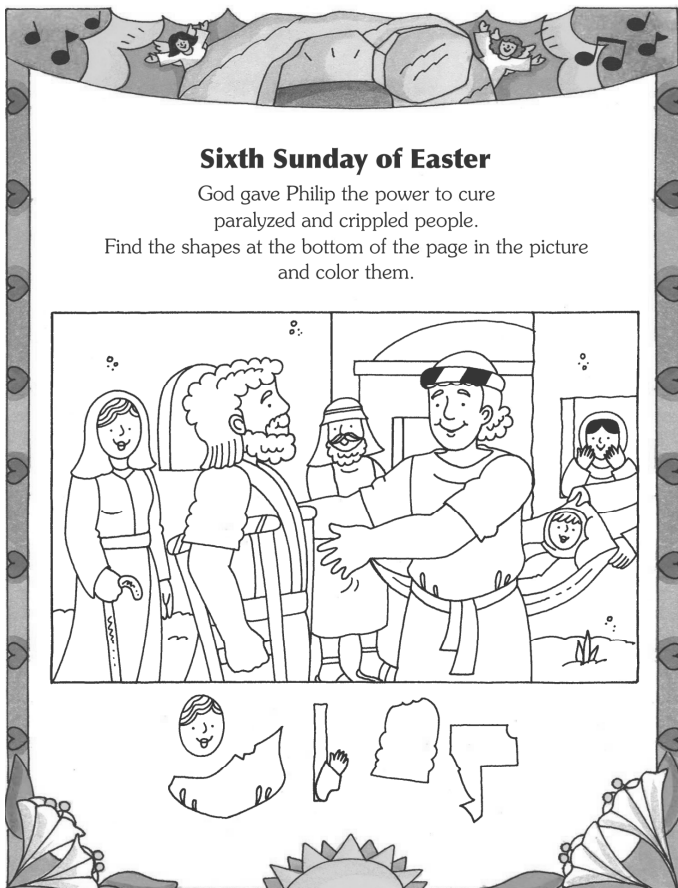
coffee filter  
clothes pin  
paint  
water

1. Lay out your coffee filter and smooth it down flat.
2. Use your paints and water to paint different colors all over the filter. The colors will run into each other if your paint brush is really wet.
3. After the paint dries, gather the middle of the filter and clothes pin it together.
4. Open the ends of the filter to display the beautiful butterfly wings.
5. Draw or paint 2 eyes on top of the clothes pin for the eyes if you wish.

For extra fun, put a strip of magnetic tape on the back and display your butterfly on the refrigerator.

Or simply tie it to the string of your blinds so it can be flying around your window.
