A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR

Happy Memorial Day Weekend! New memories will be made during this one!

I was grateful to have a break and have a guest writing this column for last week's bulletin. It was exceptionally beautiful, but only one thing was wrong with it: the author did not mention herself!

Jenny Bruni has been an amazing Confirmation program coordinator! Even during the pandemic, she has convened both first- and second-year students via google hangout, and very few have missed these Sunday opportunities. Jenny is always ready to keep the door open to anyone who wishes to be part of this preparation even if you are late or a year or two off. Know that she is already checking who in the parish is eligible to participate and you should be hearing from her soon.

Jenny has been the 'camera person' with her iPhone behind the Sunday lives-stream Masses and we are grateful to her for the example of her faith, the steadfastness in encouraging each and every young person in the parish and many other tasks no one is aware of. Thank you, Jenny. We are blessed to have you on our parish staff!

As I noted last week at Mass, Fr. Tegha graduated this past Saturday even if it was from the comfort of his room. Congratulations Fr. Tegha. We are proud of your accomplishment with highest honors! Unfortunately for us but fortunate for him, he will continue his studies for the doctorate at Notre Dame University. You know the one, where the 'fighting Irish' reign. They have offered him a full and complete scholarship including a place to stay and food to eat. He has been challenged here at times to pay for part of the tuition and we have been happy to host him at the parish in exchange for his ministry among us.

He is not scheduled to leave for Indiana until the first week of August. I told him that if classes will all be remote for the coming semester, he should avoid the winter and stay with us. I will keep you informed.

Last week we were supposed to celebrate Confirmation in the parish. In a couple of weeks, we are supposed to hold the graduation ceremony from our parochial school. Confirmation will be

rescheduled when they can. We are working on more than a virtual graduation ceremony that you will hear about. As I said last week, all these challenges to our lives before March 16 are getting tiring and wearing, but I pray for your perseverance and patience. We

are discussing how to welcome people back to the church for Mass when that is permitted, hopefully in a couple of weeks. We have already decided that the live streaming of a Mass each Sunday will continue at least through January of 2021. Even if we were to open tomorrow, seats will be limited and some of you will still be apprehensive about gathering with many people for a while.

The readings last week assure us that the Lord "walks with us along the path of life" to quote one of the Eucharistic prayers. When we ask where God is in all this mess, the answer is that He promised and is always with us. Deacon Greg Kandra has some convincing words on this theme:

A colleague emailed me, "I know God is everywhere, but it seems sometimes that he is nowhere." His unspoken question seemed to ask: "Where is God?"

It is a question that has been asked again and again throughout history—many asked it, I remember, after the tragedy of 9/11. When things seem most bleak, when the world is wracked by despair, where is hope? Where is faith?

Where is God?

I think we find one answer in last Sunday's Gospel. Just before he ascends to the Father, Jesus tells his disciples: you will not be alone. "The Father will give you another Advocate to be with you always," he says, "the Spirit of truth, you know him, because he remains with you, and will be in you. I will not leave you orphans...I will come to you."

The Advocate, of course, is the Holy Spirit. The Spirit will be with you, Jesus says. You will not be abandoned or alone. And he was right.



A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR

To those who ask, “Where is God?,” the answer is: “Look around you.” God the Holy Spirit is vibrantly, wondrously, beautifully alive. In , many places especially in this time of pandemic, he lives in the hearts of those who are caring for the sick, the elderly, the poor, the helpless. He is in the hands that reach out to bathe the old or feed the hungry. He is in the eyes that look into the faces of those who are alone. He is in the arms that embrace children who have been pushed aside. God is there. Jesus is there.

The Good News is that Jesus has not left us orphans. God lives on around us and within us. Love prevails. Hope endures.

The letter from Peter last week exhorts us: “Always be ready to give an explanation to anyone who asks you for a reason for your hope.”

Here is my explanation, my reason for hope: It is Jesus Christ! It is God’s son showing us, with open arms on the cross, just how wide is the breadth of his love.

My reason for hope? It is The Word made flesh keeping his word. It is the joy and certainty of a two-thousand-year-old promise that has been kept. It is the continuing presence of the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, doing his advocacy work in the world in astonishing and exuberant and surprising ways. I have seen it in my life and ministry.

Look around you, in this parish. Look within you, to the fire that still burns, the flame that will not die. Trust and believe here is our hope.

We are not orphans.

God—Father, Son and Spirit—is with us.




