Happy August! I hope you can get some semblance of a vacation or time away from the regular routine! And as I said last Sunday, let us all pray for this to pass, for many to be healed, for endurance for those who are responding and caring for many, for those who worry about the businesses that are on the brink of disaster. I hope storming the heavens will get all of us to be responsible and have God's favor shower health on all of us.

As I also mentioned, even though we are not sure what form it will take, August brings the new school year into focus. Teachers and administrators have not rested much this summer as they seek to learn better ways to present distant learning, and prepare the school building for a new, safer look considering the pandemic.

Thanks to a crew who moved desks out of the school as most classrooms will now have half the number of students at any given time. 
Like Fr. Tegha, he is from Cameroon and was sent by his bishop to work for a doctorate at the Jesuit School of Theology of Santa Clara University in Berkeley.



He has written the following to introduce himself:

*Fr. Ngema is a Diocesan Priest from Cameroon on study leave at the Jesuit School of Theology of Santa Clara University in view of a doctorate in biblical exegesis. Born on April 25, 1979 in Cameroon, Fr. Ngema graduated from St Thomas Aquinas' Major Seminary, Bambui - Cameroon in June 2009 and was ordained a priest for the Diocese of Buea on February 17, 2011. He has served the people of God in various capacities, often combining functions. He was the founding Pastor of Sacred Heart Parish Bomaka and the Coordinator of the Divine Mercy Co-Cathedral Project of the Diocese of Buea. He has been a lecturer and the academic dean of John Paul II Institute of Theology. He also served as the Chaplain of the health facilities of Limbe Municipality. He has a rich editorial background which traces back to his seminary days when he was the Editor-in-Chief of *SEARCHLIGHT*, the triennial magazine of his seminary. His priestly experience with Catholic Social Communications began with his appointment as Director of Divine Mercy Radio and Television Service of the Diocese of Buea. Later, he served as the Director of Catholic Communications Services of the Diocese of Buea and as the Editor of the monthly of the Catholic Bishops' Conference of Cameroon – Cameroon Panorama. Arriving the U.S for the first time on August 15, 2019, Fr. Ngema was offered temporary accommodation first at St Mary Magdalen Parish Berkeley and then St Augustine's parish Oakland. He is delighted to be offered stable residence at St Theresa's Parish Oakland and to have a canonist for his pastor since he has a strong interest in Canon Law.*

I know you will welcome him in person when you can. May the Lord continue to sustain us and bring us face to face again soon.



Our Primary Care Clinic at Children's Hospital is a federally qualified health center in Oakland. About 95% of the kids we see are underinsured and have MediCal and qualify for free lunch within their schools. Most of the kids also live in neighborhoods impacted by poverty, gun violence, substandard housing, food deserts, and other conditions that affect their health and well-being. They are from many different races and cultures, and many are newly arrived immigrants and refugees.

During the pandemic, the needs of the children of our clinic and their families have increased significantly. To address one of these needs, and to show support and care for these kids during this incredibly difficult time, we are organizing the collection of care packages for kids at our clinic. My niece who is a pre-med student in college, in consultation with my sister who is an elementary school teacher, have compiled lists of materials based on age group. The first collection will be for pre-K through 3rd grade kids who have been especially challenged with remote learning given their young age.

Place items in a bag (plastic, cloth or paper) marked St. Theresa care packages and leave it in the church vestibule between August 8th and August 23rd by the St. Theresa statue. Training is mandatory for all who minister, before starting work or volunteering and then every 3 years thereafter.

Please remember that in order to volunteer at the parish in any capacity (Lector, Eucharistic Minister, Catechist, Choir Member, St. Vincent de Paul, Legion of Mary etc.), you must complete the training.




