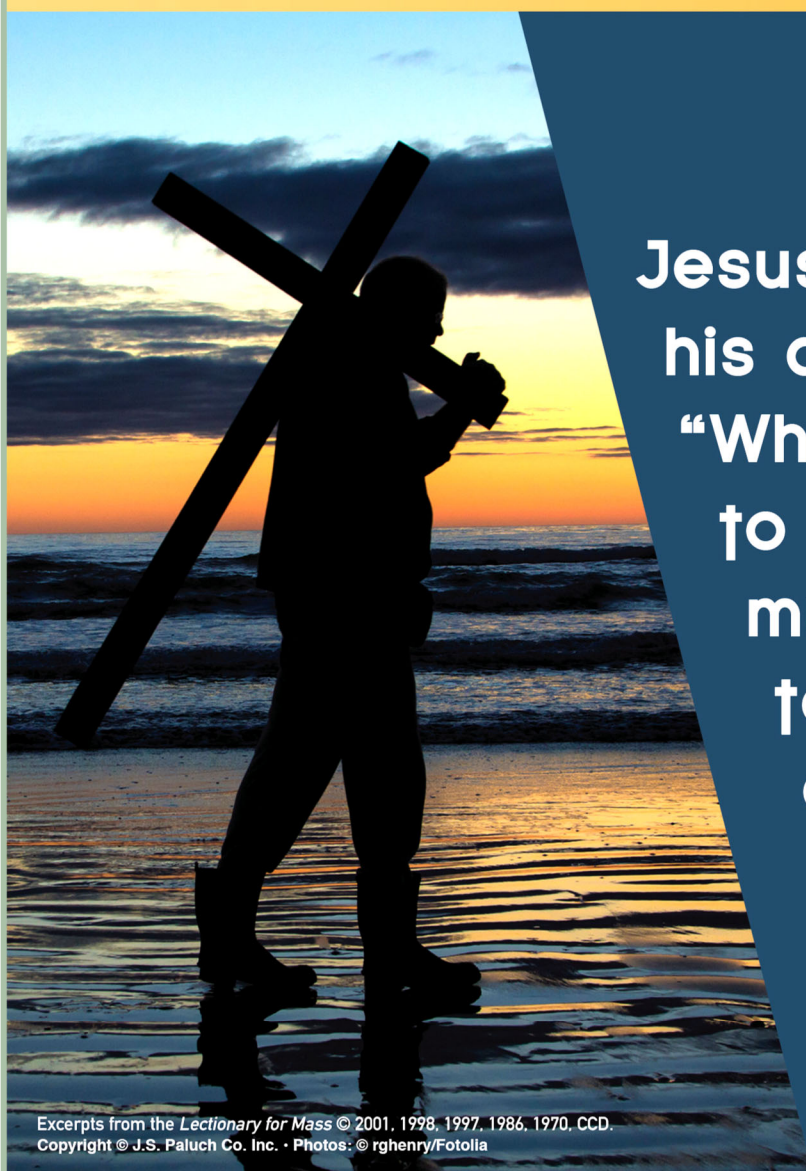

A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR

Many thanks to all who helped present a 'Back to School' Mass last week. I am grateful to the teachers and our principal who were present and all the students who were there online.

The post-Mass virtual picnic was also a great success! It is amazing how much we miss seeing each other in person and this brought a few faces to see each other again and catch up on things.

As I mentioned, we are looking into the possibility of a 'virtual parish festival/celebration' around the feast of St. Theresa. One parish nearby did this, and parishioners were offered a four-course meal from an excellent restaurant @ \$25. per person. No one had to do this but over a hundred did because it was such a great deal. Others provided their own meal, but the virtual experience of our 'chicken grill special' or a nice plate of ravioli together was wonderful to those who participated. Stay tuned and details will follow as plans evolve.

Registration for Religious Education and our Confirmation program are available at the parish website. At the Baptism ceremony, the parents who are presenting their child are reminded three times that they are the first and foremost teachers of their children in the ways of the faith. The Church prays that they will be the best of teachers. Our school and religious education programs are meant to supplement that good parental obligation. But these programs willingly and lovingly help each child and parent. I hope you will avail yourselves of this support as needed and if you want to help others and teach or witness, please contact me or the parish office.

Because of our quarantine, we postponed First Communion celebrations and Confirmation with our Vicar General. It looks like Confirmation will

be in late September. As it is finalized, we will let you know. It will probably be an outdoor ceremony so we can have a larger number of people than the ten now permitted in the church for our live streaming.

We have celebrated a couple of First Communions, but many more children are ready. Please let us know how we can help in making these celebrations happen.

I am sure some of you watched every moment of the two virtual political conventions. I know I watched more than I usually do. Nevertheless, it appears this year's election will have many complex issues to face. I encourage all to pray that the Holy Spirit will guide our nation and I encourage you to take the time to study all the issues that our nation currently faces. This is not a one issue election. That has been affirmed by our bishops. Please do research, talk with family and friends, and pray for guidance. Then make sure your voice is heard and vote.

I still remember the slogan from the Boston Tea Party that we learned in history class: "no taxation without representation". Each of us has an obligation because we are citizens to exercise this duty and obligation. It is our right, and I know we are taxed. Your voice truly makes a difference.

As we have smelled smoke all week and for many this immediately brings back memories of the Oakland fire when so many parishioners lost everything, let us continue to pray for all who face these challenges. Let us pray for all who put their lives on the line to fight these fires. May God deliver us from the pandemic soon! May God deliver us from fires and all other disasters!

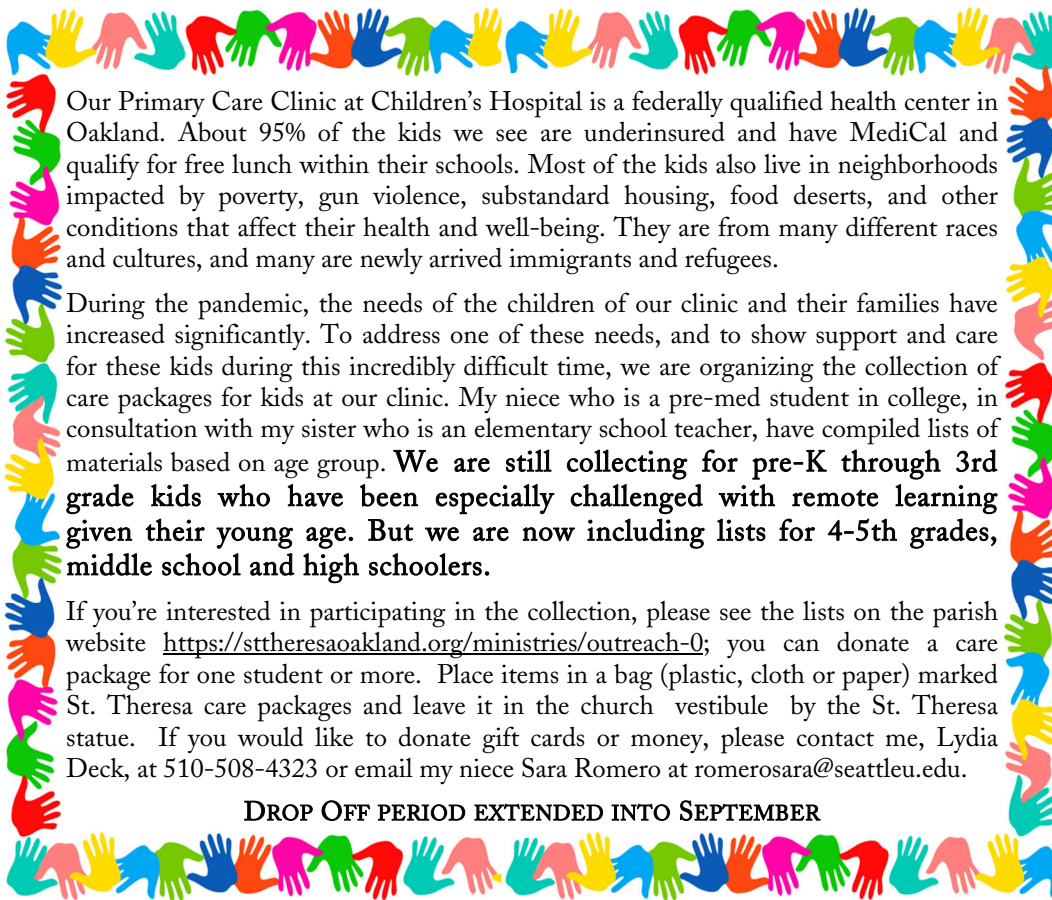

Our Primary Care Clinic at Children's Hospital is a federally qualified health center in Oakland. About 95% of the kids we see are underinsured and have MediCal and qualify for free lunch within their schools. Most of the kids also live in neighborhoods impacted by poverty, gun violence, substandard housing, food deserts, and other conditions that affect their health and well-being. They are from many different races and cultures, and many are newly arrived immigrants and refugees.

During the pandemic, the needs of the children of our clinic and their families have increased significantly. To address one of these needs, and to show support and care for these kids during this incredibly difficult time, we are organizing the collection of care packages for kids at our clinic. My niece who is a pre-med student in college, in consultation with my sister who is an elementary school teacher, have compiled lists of materials based on age group. **We are still collecting for pre-K through 3rd grade kids who have been especially challenged with remote learning given their young age. But we are now including lists for 4-5th grades, middle school and high schoolers.**







It is sometimes difficult to follow directions
 when you are not sure of the outcome.
 Try the following directions.

1. Get a piece of lined notebook paper and a pencil.
2. Turn the paper horizontally, so the lines are going up & down instead of the normal way. The red line should be at the top of the page as you look at the paper.
3. Start at the 1st blue line and count over 6 lines from the left. Draw a backward capital L from the red line down 2 inches.
4. Go back to the top of the backward L and count over 2 lines. Draw another capital L, but this time going the right way.
5. Go to the top of the L you just drew and count over 9 lines. Make another capital L, also going the correct way.
6. From the bottom right most point of that L, draw a line back up to the top line where you started the other L's.
7. Make a 5, as large as the L's you have been making, after the last shape that you have just made.
8. Now make another 5 in the space between the L and the U shape.
9. Now make the first correct capital L into an E by drawing 2 straight lines going to the right.
10. Can you read your word?



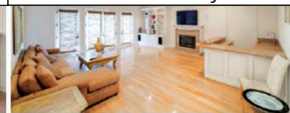
