A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR

Labor Day was the traditional end of the summer season and growing up it meant possible vacation times were over and we went back to school. I took off from writing a weekly letter for a break but will now try to get something to you each week.

Many thanks to all who made the 'Back to School' Mass and concert/picnic such a great success! Even without a green lawn a wonderful time was had by all and more importantly many of you got to reconnect after the summer and Covid confinement. The band of St. T dads has gotten better and better and even attracted some of their groupies who would not usually come to the parish.

Even after the band stopped playing at 8:15pm, about half of those who were there stayed to continue to visit with old and new friends. At 10:20pm and even when the fog had cooled everything down a neighbor to the property called and I went out to ask the remaining to lower their voices. They did go home after my request. Time soars by when you are having fun.

The school is off to a great start. Several have asked and we continue to follow county and diocesan guidelines regarding COVID, so masks do not have to be worn, but anyone who wants to be free to do so. Let's all pray for a good and Covid free year for children here and in every school.

During the summer there was a well-attended 'basketball clinic' for a couple of hours on several days. Thanks to Clarence Robinson who proposed it and guided it and to all the adult coaches who gave time to facilitate it. The kids had a blast!

We continue to keep Clarence in our prayers. He is the CYO athletic director and has faced a serious health issue. He is still working from a hospital bed on our behalf, and we pray he has a fast recovery.

The California Catholic Conference is based in Sacramento, and works for all twelve dioceses in our large state. Part of their work is to work with the state legislators to aid programs like the recent refugee resettlement program that we as a parish supported by sponsoring two families and other actions where church and state can work together. They lobby the state congress on some issues, supporting some, opposing others, and remaining neutral on most. All the bishops when they meet vote on many of these matters guiding the conference in their work. Cardinal McElroy is the current president of the California conference.

Many of you have signed up for the conference's direct reports via your email. If you haven't and are interested, just go to cacatholic.org. It is very informative.

Currently they are asking every parish to support efforts to defeat (Vote No) on Proposition 1 that will come before voters in November or whenever you choose to vote with our new mail in ballot system that will arrive soon in every mailbox.

I and most of the parish staff have attended a two-hour long webinar session regarding this matter and we are being asked to do a couple of things beginning now.

Soon a separate 'Flocknote' will go out to all who receive the weekly Friday Flocknote in a separate mailing. It will contain some excellent videos not simply on the proposition but containing great presentations about our rich Catholic 'social justice' teaching on many matters. I hope you will look at them and please let me or a staff member hear if you have any comments or questions. As a church we are not simply against abortion but are concerned about every human being and their needs from conception to a natural passing. The bishops and many lay leaders in California are working on this broader approach to do this. **Options United** is not a Catholic organization, but which promotes this fuller care our social justice teaching has always called us to embrace. In addition, we are asked with every parish to start a novena at the end of this month. More will follow in the coming weeks about this.

We are also being asked to speak about this at Sunday Mass and present bulletin inserts that the conference has prepared. I am enclosing part of one to finish this week's long column. Please expect more in the weeks to come.



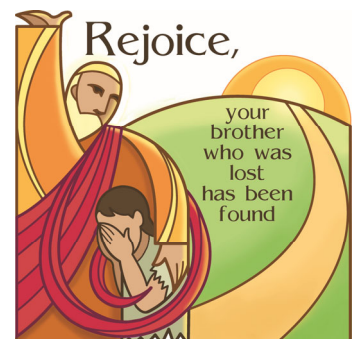
