## A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR

We thank God for the rain last week and pray that it will be the first of many rainfalls through the season that will end the drought we have been in for the past few years. When we see the devastating fires in California and several other states and countries, this parish is especially aware and remembers the Oakland fire that caused the loss of life and several hundred homes in our parish.

There are still members among us who lost their homes or remember when it came very close to the parish plant and neighborhood. I have been awed by the faith of those who lost so much. I was reminded of this again when I spoke with Nancy Sweetland's children who told me that after the fire, Nancy comforted them by saying: 'we just lost stuff.' It is good that one can become so detached, but we pray for all that they will not experience this tragedy. So, keep praying for rain!

After the fire, St. Theresa became the center for people to find each other and for people who lost everything to find a coat, food, and consolation. My predecessor, Msgr. Bernie Moran is remembered with great affection for his presence, walking the neighborhood to console, and leadership after this disaster. I hope I never have a similar task, but this is a part of what it means to be part of a parish community.

We are sisters and brothers who walk with each other through joys and sorrows reminding us that God himself also walks with us on that sometimes-treacherous path. This is why we celebrate our feast day and our parish.

Next Sunday please plan to celebrate with an outdoor Mass and the parish picnic that will follow. Games of all sorts and for all ages will welcome the children to enjoy. The Men's Club will host keeping us hydrated and please get your order in today and volunteer to help via the flocknote or parish website for a great lunch. Like

any family, we gather to celebrate good times so we can be there for each other when we face challenges.



God has called us his own and we are beloved for all the ages. Celebrating our patron who was an example of trusting God and encouraging each other is all part of God's plan. Let's help each other cooperate with that plan.

**From the California Bishops:** *A call to prayer: "even though our position in the fight against Prop 1 is not based primarily on our religious faith, we cannot neglect the power of our faith in the efforts to defeat it. Today's second reading from the letter to Timothy reminds us that we must constantly come together as one in prayer, especially to pray for those in public authority. So, we invite you with all our California bishops and the people of each diocese to encourage everyone to pray. In addition to the national ecumenical celebration of 40 Days for Life that starts on September 28, the bishops have organized a state-wide Novena to Our Lady of the Rosary to defeat Prop 1, starting on the feast of the Archangels on September 29 and ending on the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary on October 7. You can find the instructions for how to pray the Novena in the "Flocknote," or at the entrances to the church.*

*Please visit the website, where you will find a video message from one of our California bishops for each day of the Novena. Let us come together as one family to invoke the power of God through the intercession of Our Lady of the Rosary.*

At St. Theresa, the novena will be prayed each day before the morning Mass as an addition to the daily rosary that is prayed. All are welcome to join. Several other groups will also join one another to pray this, Novena. For more information, please contact me or any staff member.
