## A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR

Many thanks to all who made last week's *Rise and Shine* Mass a joyful moment in our worship! To all our young girls and boys, the notes you wrote about teachers are excellent. We will pass on many of these comments to the parochial school and Religious Ed teachers for their encouragement and guidance.

Last week's Gospel exhorted us to be a good disciple, we should learn and be like a child, trusting God, not holding grudges, accepting of all and happy. There are many other adjectives I could add, but I strongly encourage all to listen to what the children have to say and watch their daily lives. Jesus reminds us we are all God's children and sometimes we forget this so renewing the joy or our youth make help us along the way.

As I mentioned last week at Mass, after being told a number of times by PG&E that they would not fix the power line they cut, unexpectedly the Monday after before we could start speaking with administrators and supervisors, PG &E sent many workers and got it fixed by Monday afternoon. We again can use the Clarewood gate for the safety of the children who play during school hours and after school. The tall parking lights that give us security and ability to see the way, work again. The solar panels are again connected to pass the energy they store for use in our community. I don't know who or how the rapid turnaround occurred on their declaration that the cut conduit and power lines were private ownership and we had to fix it ourselves, but if you had anything to do with it, more than a million thanks for your intervention.

Progress, but slow progress continues to be made on the repairs on the Event center, meeting rooms, computer lab, school, and parish multi-purpose building. Major trenches have now been sealed with waterproofing materials, vents have been given better access and some of the gravel you see in the parking lot has been moved in to fill the trenches around the multi-purpose building. A lot of repair and work is beginning to happen in the

gym. The contractor, and many others have documented every step of the way and I hope to have a presentation night so those who are interested can see the progress that has been done. Again, especially those who will have to bring their basketball or volleyball practice to St. Lawrence's gym or St. Augustine's gym, thanks for making accommodations so our teams can have a great season.



Last weekend a diocesan wide cross-country meet took place. It occurred on a beautiful and not too hot day. Someone told me the crowd was about a third of the previous years. Congratulations to all who participated and for getting St. Theresa high in the standings of all teams ranked. These small events remind us we are slowly getting back to life before covid.

Please plan to attend and place your food order as we celebrate Mass on October 3 for our patronal feast day. This event will also have changes and accommodations from years past but is another step toward getting back to what we have missed. It won't be the same without you.

Pope Francis is up and running just after a few weeks of recovery from major surgery. On the plane back from a short pastoral trip he reminded us that **all are welcome** to be part of us. He was very clear when he told reporters that he has never denied Communion to anyone in his entire life. I can make the same statement and intend to follow the guidance given by the Holy Father. Invite someone to Mass this coming week. Welcome and introduce yourself to someone you don't know in Church. Let us pray for all who have walked away because they did not feel welcome. A smile, a greeting, an acknowledgement can go a long way. St. Theresa Parish has been described by a number of people to be a welcoming community. I invite all to make sure that is true week after week after week.







## MESSENGERS OF GOD

On September 29 we celebrate the feast of Saints Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael, Archangels. Angels are "messengers of God." They announce to us that God is with us to give us strength and protection, guidance and health. The "voice of an archangel" is mentioned in 1 Thessalonians 4:16.

Michael is one of the archangels. His name means "Who is like God?" Michael, the defender of Christians and of the Church, is mentioned in the Bible in the books of Daniel (10:12-13) and Revelation (12:7-9).

Another archangel is Gabriel. The name Gabriel means "God is my strength." Gabriel is the angel who announced to Mary that she would become the mother of Jesus (Luke 1:26), and told Zechariah about the expected birth of his son, John (Luke 1:8), the future Baptizer who would point the way to Jesus. Eastern Orthodox Catholics remember that announcement to Zechariah today, September 23.



The Archangel Raphael, whose name means "God is my health," is a helper and guide in many stories of the Old and New Testaments (see Tobit 12:3, 15).

On this feast of these archangels, bake some cookies in the shape of an angel.

(You might have to bring out your Christmas cookie cutters!)

Decorate them and give them to friends and family with a message like,

"May the angels remind you of God's love and bring sweetness to your life."
