As a community of faith, we believe that the prevention of child sexual abuse begins with each person. Increased awareness and a willingness to take action are steps for every person to take to eradicate abuse in our society, in the community, in the neighborhood, and in the family.

All those who minister (volunteers, employees and clergy) in the Diocese of Oakland are to be educated about the nature of child sexual abuse, how it is perpetrated, how to report it and strategies for prevention. Training is mandatory for all who minister, before starting work or volunteering and then every 3 years thereafter.

Please remember that in order to volunteer at the parish in any capacity (Lector, Eucharistic Minister, Catechist, Choir Member, St. Vincent de Paul, Legion of Mary, CYO etc.), you must complete the training.

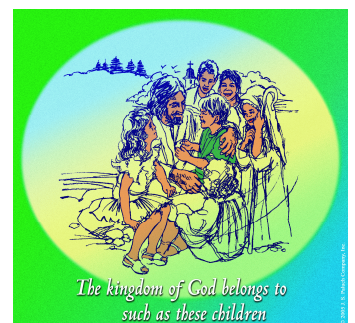

## Twenty-seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

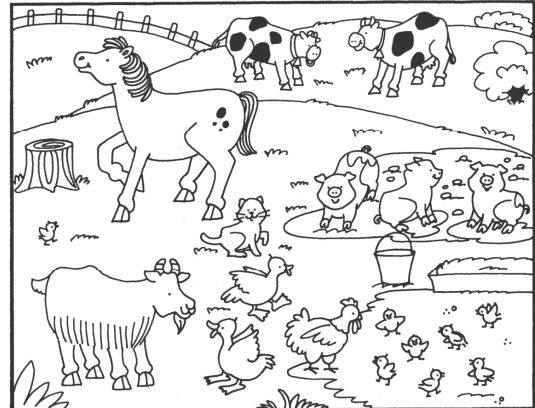

Do you have brothers and sisters? Did you ever think of the sun and moon as your brother or sister?

On October 4 we celebrate the feast of St. Francis. Francis loved all of creation and was grateful for all the wonderful things God created for us. He taught everyone to appreciate and be thankful for all of God's gifts.

He wrote a song of gratitude and praise called "Canticle of the Creatures," naming many parts of creation and describing how they praise God just by being what they were created to be.

He sang of "Brother Sun" and "Sisters Moon and Stars."

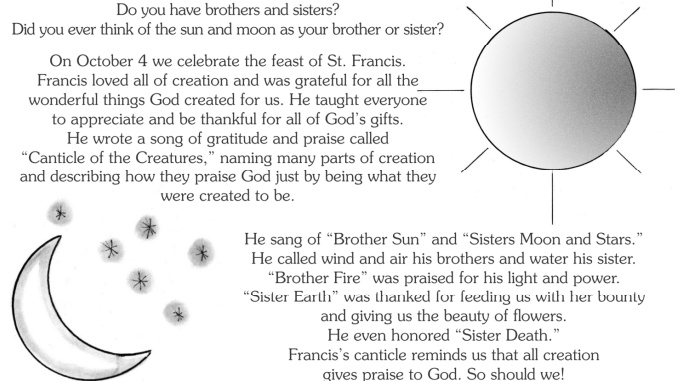
He called wind and air his brothers and water his sister.

"Brother Fire" was praised for his light and power.

"Sister Earth" was thanked for feeding us with her bounty and giving us the beauty of flowers.

He even honored "Sister Death."

Francis's canticle reminds us that all creation gives praise to God. So should we!
