A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR

I want to encourage all to continue the good work you have been doing confronting the 'virus' and keeping each of us safe and free from this terrible plague. With the cooler weather and we pray rain beginning, it will be more difficult to meet outside, or keep our homes and offices open for air flow. I simply want to say that I know we can do it! Hopefully very soon this will all be a bad memory.

That encouragement in part comes from how you have cooperated with the social distancing when you reserve a place in church for Mass. Thank you for following the directions of the ushers and as difficult as it is, for moving off the property quickly without the normal interaction and meeting of friends.

You with those who have volunteered to check people in, taking our temperature, making sure we sanitize our hands, keeping our masks on during the whole Mass, following the different route on the Communion line, and then helping to clean each pew after someone has used it has all kept our Mass open for you to come. Keep up the good work and we hope a second Mass will be back soon to the weekend schedule.

ST. THERESA PUBLIC MASSES

Our weekend Mass schedule is Sunday at 10:00 am which will continue to be live-streamed. The weekday Mass schedule is Monday - Friday, 8:30 am.

Due to the limited number (100) of people (which includes clergy/staff/volunteers) who are allowed in the church you must register for Sunday Mass. A Flocknote is sent out every Tuesday with the link to place a reservation for the upcoming Sunday. Reservations will be taken from noon Tuesday through noon Thursday. You may also go to https://sttheresaoakland.org/Mass_Reservation to make a reservation.

On Sunday we ask those who have attend Mass leave using Clarewood for the safety of those who are lined-up and arriving for Walk-Up communion.

If you are in a high-risk group, or even apprehensive about attending Mass, we ask you to please stay home, and join us for Mass via live-stream on our Facebook page. The dispensation from attending Mass remains in effect in the Diocese of Oakland.

Walk-Up Holy Communion will continue to be available following the Sunday 10:00 am Mass IN THE VESTIBULE OF THE CHURCH. Please arrive and leave using Clarewood.

We will be collecting hygiene kits. Please drop off items in the vestibule by St. Theresa Statue between November 8- November 30th. Pantry needs- smaller/consumer package quantities are preferred: Nutritional drinks, oatmeal, cream of wheat, grits, cereal, breakfast bars, peanut or almond butter, jelly, mayonnaise, mustard, ketchup, pickles, cans of chicken, beans, salmon, tuna, turkey or Vienna sausage, Spam. Also pasta, rice, spaghetti sauce, ramen noodles, canned or packaged soups, chili, beans or stew. Canned fruits or dried fruits. Packages of pudding, jello or apple sauce or fruit cups. Cookies, chips and crackers. Tea bags or instant coffee.

Hygiene kits- During this time of COVID items must be NEW and Unopened. You can place in Ziplock bags ready packaged or give individual items- masks, hand sanitizer, soap, shampoo & conditioner (travel size), toothbrush, toothpaste, floss, tissue packs, sanitary products for women, shaving items for men, and CLEAN NEW SOCKS !






With the holidays approaching, get a head start by making your own wrapping paper this year. Use your talents and/or show your talents on the wrapping paper.


- Suggested materials are brown paper bags that you have cut open, markers, crayons, ink pads, rubber stamps of any kind, and Christmas cookie cutters.
