### **Merry Christmas!**

On behalf of I and the entire staff of St. Theresa's Parish, we wish you a happy and holy Season of Christmas!

Our prayer and wish is that the mystery of love that we celebrate with the event that happened centuries ago in Bethlehem will continue to bless your lives and the lives of all you love.

### HOLY FAMILIES

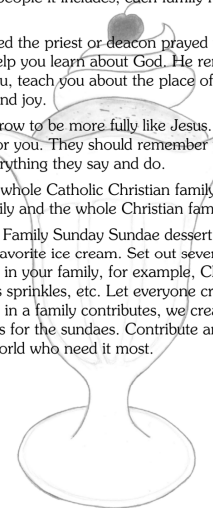
Learning to live like Jesus is hard. You need the help of many people. No matter what your family looks like or how many people it includes, each family member must be an example of love, care, joy, and holiness.
